### **Digital Inclusion Week Events**

- SOESD hosting summit on Oct 11th in Medford
  - Free for school district members, \$50 for others
  - Speakers include Victor (regular RV BAT member)
  - Focus on equity aspects related to broadband

### **Grant Updates**

- Jackson County Library submitted collaborative Digital Equity grant
  - Aims to expand DART program, continue Starlink for mobile connectivity
  - Upgrade classroom PCs, fund bilingual digital services specialist
  - Marketing initiatives to raise awareness of library resources

### **Organization Updates**

- Josephine Community Library:
  - Computer basics class started Sept 13th with 7/10 slots filled
  - 50+ person waitlist; expanding to WorkSource locations

- Spanish classes starting in November
- Ashland Senior Services:
  - Collaborating with JCLS on tech basics classes
  - Offering specialized topics like streaming music
  - Challenge: motivating reluctant learners to engage with digital literacy
- Jackson County Library:
  - Planning AI basics class for November to address fears/misconceptions
  - Continuing digital legacy and cybersecurity classes
  - New dedicated class on password management
  - Spanish computer basics classes planned for late 2024/early 2025
- Hunter Communications:
  - Awaiting ARPA grant announcement (expected by end of October)
  - Exploring micro-trenching for faster residential builds
  - Grant would target underserved Shady Cove/Trail/Prospect areas
- Greater Applegate:
  - Successful fundraising week with electronic recycling drive
  - Sponsoring Starlink program for Applegate Valley businesses
- T-Mobile:
  - Expanded Project 10 Million data allowances for student hotspots
  - "Friday Night 5G Lights" grant program for school stadiums
  - First emergency alert via satellite connectivity implemented nationally

## **Education Initiatives**

- SOESD discussing implications of Senate Bill 3 on tech skills education
- Developing curriculum for required class (graduating class of 2027)
- Seeking input on essential technical competencies for students
