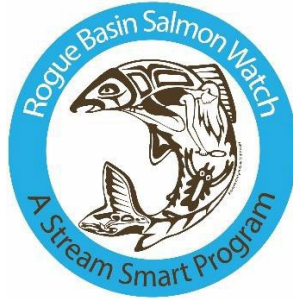


Stream Smart (TMDL and Stormwater) – Highlights

Pre Program Results

- 527 respondents completed the survey before the program (pre-program).
 - Average score was 3.85.
 - 8 questions were frequently missed
 - The two lowest ranked questions answered correctly were #9 (2% correct) and number 8 (13% correct).

Post Program Results

- 354 respondents completed a post survey (post program)
 - Average score was 6.29 (increase of 63.4%)
 - Only 2 questions were frequently missed
 - The two lowest ranked questions answered correctly were #9 (9% correct) and number 8 (27% correct).

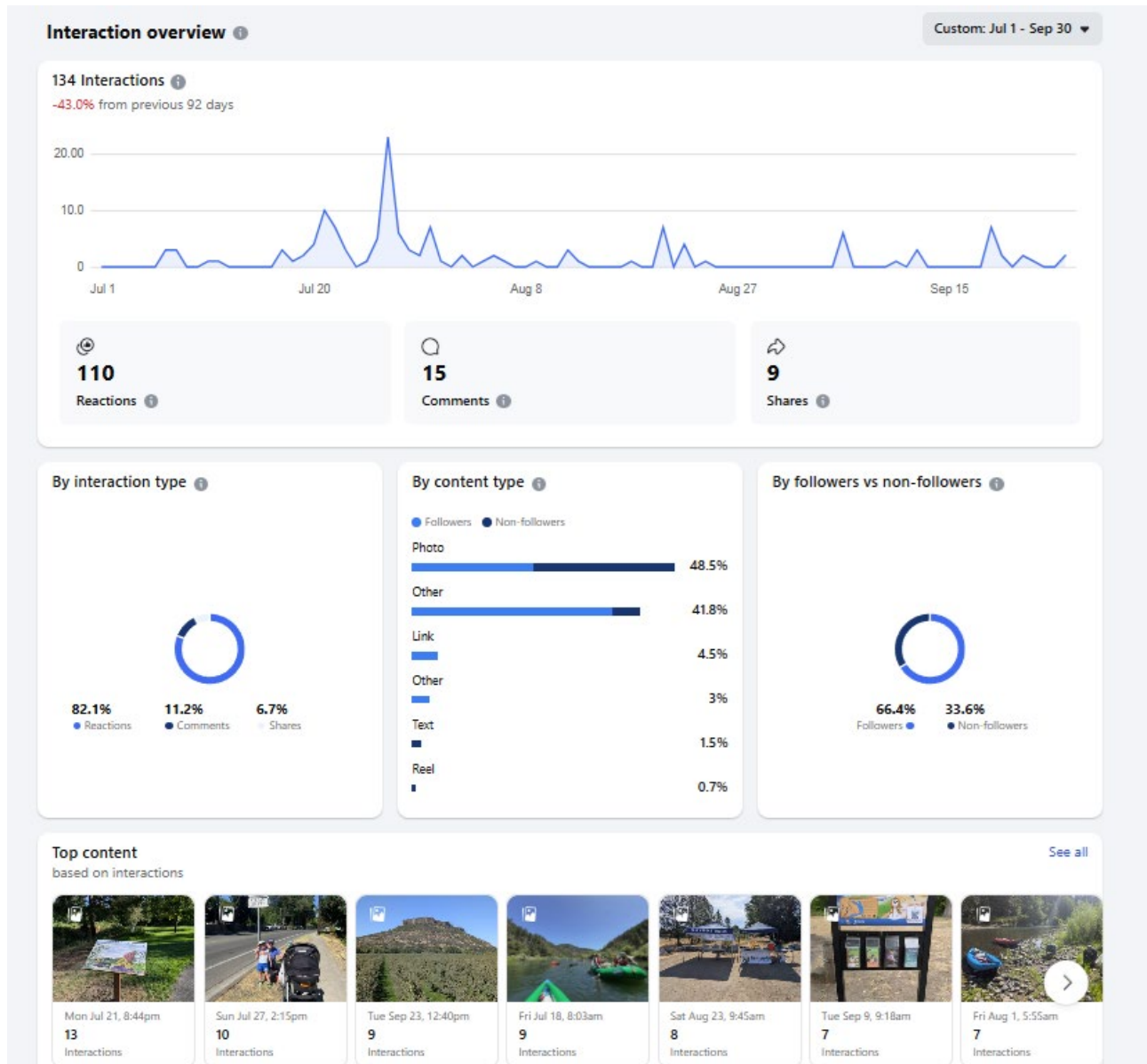
